DIRECTIONS

TO MURTHA CULLINA LLP:

From the North: Route 93 and Route 1 converge at the Leonard P. Zakim Bunker Hill Bridge heading south. Once inside the tunnel, take Exit 23/Purchase Street/South Station. Stay to the right. You will be on Purchase Street. Turn right onto Summer Street. Turn right onto High Street. Parking is available at the 100 High Street parking garage on the left, look for the Parking sign. The entrance to our 99 High Street offices is directly across the street.

From the South: Take Southeast Expressway (I-93N) to Exit 20 (Mass. Turnpike/South Station). Stay in the left lane. Follow the signs for South Station/Chinatown. Continue straight on Lincoln Street. Turn right onto Summer Street. Take next left onto High Street. Parking is available at the 100 High Street parking garage on the left, look for the Parking sign. The entrance to our 99 High Street offices is directly across the street.

From the West: Take Mass. Turnpike (I-90) to Exit 24A (South Station). Keep left at the fork on the ramp and follow signs for Atlantic Avenue. Turn left onto Summer Street. Turn right onto High Street. Parking is available at the 100 High Street parking garage on the left, look for the Parking sign. The entrance to our 99 High Street offices is directly across the street.
