DIRECTIONS

DIRECTIONS TO THE ROCKY HILL MARRIOTT:

From the North: Follow I-91 South to Exit 23. At top of ramp, turn left. At second traffic light, turn right. Hotel is first entrance on right.

From the South: Take I-91 North to Exit 23. At top of ramp, turn right. Hotel is ahead on left hand side.

DIRECTIONS TO THE BOSTON MARRIOTT NEWTON:

From the East (Logan Airport & Boston/Cambridge): Follow signs to Boston/Sumner Tunnel. Take Sumner Tunnel toward I-93 South. When you exit the tunnel, the road bears to the right; immediately get into the left lane and make a U-turn onto I-93 South. Continue on I-93 through the South Station Tunnel. Stay in the right lane and take Exit 20 (Mass Pike I-90 West). When approaching the second toll booth, stay in the right lane and take Exit 15 (third Newton Exit). Drive straight after the tolls and follow the signs for Rte. 30 East Weston/Wayland. At the set of lights take a right. Follow the road for about one mile and the hotel will be ahead on the left.

From the West: Take the Mass Pike I-90 East to Exit 14. Follow signs for Rte. 128/I-95 North to Exit 24 for Rte. 30 Newton/Wayland. Turn right at the top of the ramp onto Rte. 30 East. The hotel is 0.3 miles ahead on the left.

From the South: Take Rte. 128/I-95 North to Exit 24 (immediately after the MBTA exit). The exit sign reads "Exits 23-24-25." After Exit 25, take Exit 24 (sign will read "Rte. 30 Newton/Wayland"). Turn right at the top of the ramp onto Rte. 30 East. The hotel will be 0.3 miles ahead on the left.

From the North: Take Rte. 128/I-95 South to Exit 24 (Rte. 30 Newton/Wayland). Turn right at the top of the ramp onto Rte. 30 East and the hotel is 0.4 miles ahead on the left.
